Al Literacy, Ethics, and Guidelines

Teach students to understand Al's capabilities and limitations. Build a foundation of AI literacy and ethics to guide responsible and thoughtful use.



Supervised / Guided Instruction

Bring essential skills back into the classroom. If AI is replacing learning at home, have students research, write, and practice critical skills under your supervision (just like we did with calculators).



Processes for Out-of-Class Work

Adopt process tools to track how student work develops over time. Use strategies like video playback and frequent student conferencing to monitor progress and ensure authentic engagement.



Durable Assessments

Design durable tasks and assessments that students cannot use a chatbot or vision on their phones to complete. For more, see skills21.org/durable.



Al Integration

See Al as a collaborator. Use it to inspire creativity, boost problem-solving, and personalize learning, while keeping students at the center of the process.
